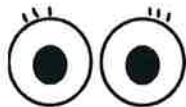

Dear Amanda-Clearcreek Families,

I hope this letter finds everyone healthy and well. As you are aware, today - February 2, 2021 - was our fifth and final calamity day. As we navigate the remainder of winter, I want to notify you how we will handle inclement weather days moving forward.

If road conditions, wind chill factors, or unforeseen issues result in us not being able to have our students attend school in person, we will transition to remote learning.

We will ask all students to take their personal device and other learning resources home when forecasts indicate we may be unable to transport our students safely. Due to our schedule not allowing us to have two-hour delays as in the past, wind chill factors may result in us being closed for in-person instruction. If this is the case, our remote instruction will look as it has the two previous times we have had to move to remote learning.

I will keep you informed if there are any changes to this schedule.
