

Trailblazer Academy General Information

Ohio Christian University offers three options to students in grades seven through twelve:

- Take college courses at the OCU main campus in Ohio
- Take college courses online through OCU
- Take college courses at your school, if offered through an agreement with your school district

Benefits of participation in Trailblazer Academy:

- Potentially earn college credit free, a tremendous cost savings
- The ability to earn a college degree while completing the requirements of high school
- Ohio College Credit Plus courses are weighted the same as AP and IB courses
- 15 and 30 credit hour pathways for various fields to comply with the Ohio College Credit Plus requirements for high schools
- An advanced, challenging, and rewarding environment
- A wide variety of courses that are transferrable to other Ohio public institutions (see www.ohiohighered.org/transfer/tag)

When to apply:

- All non-public students planning to apply for state funding must have ALL application materials in by March 18th to meet the funding form application deadline of April 1st.
- Application priority deadline for public students is May 3rd for the Fall 2020 semester.

How to apply:

- Complete the Trailblazer Academy Application
- Submit an official high school transcript or junior high school report card
- Submit an official qualifying test score.
 - Trailblazer Academy requires at least a 19 or high composite ACT score, a 990 composite SAT score, or a 250+ AccuPlacer Next-Generation Reading score.
 - Some specific courses require alternate testing and course prerequisites. Please contact our office for more detailed information on requirements.
